Description of cut subject : "FCREST FIRE"

Today, 19-6-56 at 00,30 I arrived at scene of the previous days disaster in which I9 members of Security forces lost their lives and I8 were injured. All concerned were taking part in the operation "Lucky Alphone" Some of the dead were taking part in fighting a fire others being relieved from patrol dutytrack which they normally have been guarding during the operations The fire which was under central, when a wind whipped it into a raging inferno which trapped the troops who were fighting it also those who were changing patrol duty. The length of time taken to cause this disaster is estimated at three minutes. Y Vehicles trapped or blocking the road were pushed over side to allow rescue teams to get to the scene. Helicopters also played a big part in rescue work by dropping doctors and medical supplies to stricken area. Today as x I toured area from I2 30 until & 9 c'clock the scene was one of desolation and reminded me of scenes from some hygone ago. No life - just miles of fire ravaged country, black and decolate.
