

DUKE OF EDINBURGH AT TEXTILE INDUSTRY

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At Leeds Station the Duke of Edinburgh was greeted by the Earl of Scarborough and the Lord Mayor of Leeds, as he arrived there on his way to open the new Man-Made-Fibres Building of the city's university.

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The new plant and building costing half-a-million-pounds puts the Department of Textile Industries at Leeds University in the forefront of ^{WORLD} research.

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Just as 40-years-ago the university studied wool, cotton, flax and jute, so nowadays the machines and the processes are available to students of the newest synthetic fibres and the Duke and the Princess Royal (who is Chancellor of the University) were able to inspect the facilities and the products.

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
