

## BOAT RACES AT PISA

Another quaint survival from mediaeval times is the boat race staged on the river Arno in Italy in the shadow of the famous leaning tower of Pisa.

The crews and the boats are entered on behalf of the four areas which once were independent republics, Venezia, Amalfi, Genova and Pisa herself and the ceremonies are those enacted now for generations.
