## New dighways across Tibet

In Ihese/Ti' t, a convey of motor lorries gets ready to start out on a route which will take them over two new highways linking the cities of Ihasa and Shigatse and Shigatse and Gyantse.

To mark the opening of the new roads to traffic great celebrations were held in Lhase and Shigatse.

The motor convoy moves across the vast pasture lands and then climbs towering peaks some 15,000 feet above see level. It used to take eight days to travel from Ihasa to Shigatee, now it takes only two. What used to be a two-day-jeurney from Shigatee to Gyantse now takes only 5 hours. The two highways have brought the eastern and western parts of Tibet closer together than aver before. Many people have come afar to welcome the convoy.

With opening of the new highways, large quantities of goods will now reach western Tibet.
