These shots all 4" shots which I had to hand-hold as I only reached the finishing point as the winner came

(The Winner (Colin Williams from Deptford) passing finishing point indicated by official in boat holding up White Flag.

Shot of Officials launch going alongside winner in midstream and Colin Williams being congratulated by the Prime Warden, Wing Commander G.C. Maxwell, M.C. D.F.C., A.F.C., A.E.M.)

Shot from Embankment showing Winner coming alongside Cadogan Pier.
