20 ace drivers of six countries competed at Nurburgring.

The spectacular 14-mile circuit is a terrific test of driving ability. No. 1, J. M. Fangio, was in the lead, Peter Collins on his tail. Both drove Ferraris. Another great racing figure, Stirling Moss, was not far behind on a Maserati. One of those three, it was felt even in the early stages, would win the 310-mile race.

Moss took second place after Peter Collins drove into the ditch.

Fangio was the winner. A brilliant performance, to win the German Grand Prix at 85.6 m.p.h.
