Two bombs explored this morning at the Cyprus Broadcasting Service some 3 miles from Nicosia, this is the second time since april the 1st. of 1955 where the transmiter and other equipment have been destroyed. Early this morning at 1.30 one bomb exploded in the stores of the station where a new transmiter not in operation was damaged as well as other cases with other staff was destroyed. Later at 7 am another time bomb exploded in the yard ofnthe station where in the tent for the British troops who are on night guard. Lucktly when the second bomb went off the troops have already left for their tamp 20 minuits before. Roll.1. showing shots of the damages at the stores where can be seen the roof of the entrance being damaged. also the cases out of the stores some of them damaged. several shots of these as well as a long shot of the storeges... other shots are from the tent where are seen damages in the tent a bed made of iron used by the troops was blown out on the sand bags, and other shots of the cotton wool on the groung after the expolsion in the tent, ther shots are from the Radio station showing general view of it, with the long tower where day and night policemen are guarding the place.
