Prohibation of the Communists Party in the Federal Republic

The Federal Constitutional Court in Karlsruhe has pronounced the Communists Party of Germany to be unconstitutional and has prohibited this Party. This prohibition was was received without especial surprise, and the actions of the police were accomplished without any incidents.
