In Karlsruhe the West German Constitutional Court

prohibited the Communist Party and declared it allegal. There
was no reaction among the party of the Federal Republic,
was
but it/quite a different matter in East Berlin, where

10,000 people attended a protest meeting. Eastern Germany
is, of course, a Communist country and felt bound to object
to the action of the West.

Water ski experts competed at Copenhagen in the European Championship. Mariana Doria lost a ski and that put Switzerland out of the running. Now an Italian competitor.
