

The funeral of His Eminence Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster will take place in Westminster Cathedral on Tuesday 28th August.

A Solemn Dirge will be sung at 6 p.m. on Monday the 27th. Pontifical Requiem Mass will be sung by The Most Reverend J.H. King, Archbishop-Bishop of Portsmouth, at 11 a.m. on Tuesday.

The lying-in-state will take place in Westminster Cathedral Hall, Ambrosden Avenue, on Sunday, 26th August from 10 a.m. until 9 p.m. and on Monday, the 27th, from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. No flowers by request. 4

Seats at the Requiem will be reserved, as far as possible, for members of the Diplomatic Corps, peers, M.P.s, founders, benefactors and seat-holders of the Cathedral and members of the Society of St. Augustine.
