Airport beauties

LONDON AIRPORT is to hold its first international beauty contest. Ground receptionists of 34 British and international airlines have been invited to compete for the first "Miss London Airport" title.

Finals for the contest, in which each airline will be asked to submit one entrant, will be judged in the recently opened airport roof garden during the Battle of Britain Week, September 9-15.

Sir John D'Albiac, the retiring London Airport commandant, will be asked to join a panel of film stars to choose the airport's most beautiful girl.

One of the organisers says: "Every organisation and holiday centre in Britain elects a beauty queen. But some of the prettiest girls in the country work at London Airport, and do a very important job at Britain's shop window."

The contest is organised under the approval of a committee of all airlines using the airport. So far four airlines have chosen girls to represent them.

MISS LONDON AIRPORT CONTEST.

The Judging of the Miss London Airport Contest is to take place in the Rest Gardens on the Roof of the Queens Building London Airport Central at 15.00 Hours on Thursday the 13th of September.

Contestants should report to the foyer of the Grill Room Queens Building at 13.30 Hours on the 13th where a private room has been laid on for their convenience. There will be a dummy run for the Contestants at 14.00 Hours on the Roof Gardens. Then they will return to the Grill Room at 14.30 to meet the Judges.

Contestant should be wearing normal uniform. They will be judged on three counts... personality, deportment and appearance.

After the Judging contestants are invited to take Tea with the Judges in the Queens Building.

The majority of Prizes given by Airport Concessionaires will go to the Contestant elected Miss London Airport, but there will be a prize each for the two runners up.
