SPAIN.

Our cameraman at Irun and Zaragossa has sent back dramatic pictures of the fighting in the key area; of the Spanish civil war --- the fate of these towns determines the fate of Spain. At Burgos the rebels and Government troops are at close quarters. Following artillery bombardment the insurgent troops raid a hill-top and pick up the outpost. Daily the toll of dead a dwounded mounts higher. Under the hail of rifle and shell-fire you see our cameraman's discarded car, disabledry in the actin in which many lost their lives. Here at San Sebastian Government troops are seen raiding a farmhouse where the occupants, we suspected of rebel activities --- are captured, searched and taken away. Not far away towns and villages are blazing under the incendiary bombs of air raiders. General Cabanellas, head of the Provisional Government, is condident of victory as fresh contingents of Moors from across the water contingent march towards Madrid.
