The most terrible train wreck in the history of Indian railways --- an express crowded with Mohammedans on their way to a festival at Calcutta plunged down an embankment at Dilta killing more than a hundred passengers, and injuring twice that number.

Most of the victims were poor villagers, packed together in the front portion of the train. Scenes of indexcribable horror followed on the disaster, as doctors and wax rescue workers from Patna gave what relief they could. The injured in the carly light of the Indiana.
