Unrest in Palestine. Suspecting that the Higher Committee, had incited Arab leaders to start a Holy War against the British Government, police swooped on the secret head quarters of assassins and rebels. Many arrests were made. The Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, head of the Moslem Supreme Council, was deprived of his office --- many other high officials were taken on board the cruiser Sussex --- deported to an island in the Indian Ocean. In Palestine itself the frontiers are guarded with special vigilance --- all roads leading to Jerusalem patrolled. Troops which should have left for other stations have been ordered to remain until the situation returns to normal. ~~If necessary it will be martial law~~ --- the British Government is determined to stamp out terrorism.
