

LYNCH v KANE.

Benny Lynch of Glasgow defended his title of world flyweight champion against Peter Kane at Shawfield Park, Glasgow. Sensation in Round I --- With a flashing left Lynch put Kane down. Kane is wearing striped trunks.

Round II --- big-eyed Peter Kane is good but he 's up against ~~me~~ a better, and soon Lynch rocked him back on his heels. Again the pace in this round is terrific.

Rounds 3 and 4 passed without any outstanding incident, but in Round 5 Benny put Peter on the canvas again.

Round 8 Kane landed a hefty right --- and that stung Lynch into a colossal counter-attack, with arms ripping into the Golborne boy like machine gun fire.

Round 9 --- standing up and slogging --- more action in one round than you get in the whole of many a heavyweight fight.

By Round 12, Peter Kane was beginning to look scarred with battle, but still he was full of fight. He's tiring now and the champion follows up every advantage, ~~and again Kane goes down.~~ Lynch now is out for a finish --- the crowd screams as he bangs away with both hands.
