

ARMY IN EGYPT.

Britain's troops are on manoeuvres in the eastern district of Egypt near the Suez Canal. Officially these are exercises of the Cavalry Brigade; but like most other Cavalry Brigades the 7th, 8th and 11th Hussars are mechanised. Light and medium tanks, armoured cars and guns from the units at Abbassia raise the dust of the ageless desert near Cairo, with the rumblings of imitation war.
