ANTHONY EDEN RESIGNS.

Mr Anthony Eden, Britain's Foreign Secretary, has resigned from the Cabinet following a difference of opinion with the Premier, Mr Neville Chamberlain. Britain's relations with Italy were the cause of the break. Lord Halifax was immediately suggested as successor in the Foreign Office. Crowds waited in Downing Street while the Cabinet meetings were being held, and when Mr Eden walked to No. 10 he was cheered lustily. Later, Mr Eden and Mr ~~Eden~~, Chamberlain drove to Parliament where each gave his reasons for the resignation. ~~The following~~ ^{Next} day Mr Eden drove to Buckingham Palace to hand over the Seals of Office to the King. Mr Eden has left the Cabinet, but he still enjoys the high esteem of ~~his~~ ^{his} all colleagues and the general public. At a late night session of Parliament, a vote of censure on the Government was defeated ~~by 330 to 168~~ in the House of Commons by 330 votes to 168.
