Spread over the spacious Ayrshire countryside -- - the course for the Scottish Grand National at Bogside. And spacious is the word, for sometimes the horses almost got lost in the distance. Several Aintree horses took part in the entire are Southern Hero, Blue Prince and Didoric among the ten that started on the three and a half mile gallop.

In the early part of the race Rightun led from outhern Hero into the lead. If he doesn't go the wrong side of those mountains he'll have a good chance. Notice the finish Mr James V. Rank's Young Mischief was leading from the same owner's Southern Hero -- and Young Mischief won by four lengths. His price was ten to one --- so that shows you the evils of betting.
