10,000 Poles celebrated the 25th anniversary of the march out of Cracow of Pilsudski's first legion in 1914, for the world war fronts. Marshal Smigly-Rydz, Inspector General of the Army, reviewed the legion before an immense crowd who had come from all parts of Poland. ~~It is~~ ⁱⁿ the historic town of Cracow, that Marshal Pilsudski and the national hero Kosciusko were buried, under huge tumuli built by the Poles themselves. The whole town was decorated with white and red national flags, also white and blue flags, the colours of the first legion. The legionaries wore the old blue caps of wartime. Thus did Poland honour her heroes of the Great War.
