On board the Aircraft Carrier Victorious Albecore bombers lined up in packed ranks to go roaring over the Now the Fulmer fighters take off in turn. flight deck While these planes were heading towards Kirkenes, Swordfish bears from Furious were bound for Petsamo.

They went to hammer the harbours of Kirkenes in Norther Norway and Findand's Petsamo. At Petsamo, jetties, harbour works and oil tanks were subjected to a hail of bombs with devastating effect: at Kirkenes a German warship and four supply ships were hit.
