Tornado--

America- where the dreaded spring tornadoes-(or "twisters" as they're called)- hurtled across the New England ~~country~~ countryside, leaving a death roll running into three figures, and damage amounting to millions of dollars. Thousands were made homeless by the storms, <sup>which</sup> ~~as they~~ completely levelled even <sup>sturdy</sup> ~~well~~-built houses. Many <sup>more</sup> ~~of them~~ were torn apart like boxes- and ~~whirled~~ whirled miles away- in the worst visitation for 75 years.
