After the Prime Minister, Lord Brookeborough, had welcomed her Majesty,  
with, (as he said), "a loving greeting" - from the people of Northern

On to the City Hall - where the Royal Visitors are received by the Lord  
Mayor, Alderman Percival Brown - who was later knighted by her Majesty
