Fresh earth tremors shake stricken Argostoli- capital of the largest to the Ionian Group- bringing further desolation and misery to Greece's Islands of Legend.

Meanwhile, rescue work continues - helped by men of the Royal Navy - For British ships were first to arrive on the scene of tragedy. Britain had, once again, proved her lifelong friendship with Greece.

Organising Red Cross relief measures were was Lady Mountbatten, while Admiral Lord Mountbatten- naval Chief in the Mediterranean- had emergency supplies brought to the area.

Besides Cephalonia, the islands of Zante and Ithaca- in the Ionian Sea- have been almost totally destroyed.

Even as these pictures were taken in the harbour of Ithaca- new cracks were appearing in the ground.

Help was at hand- for the other stricken islands- as sailors from H.M.S. "Daring" arrived with food for the hapless victims.

A great problem remains -- to prevent an outbreak of mass axidemic opidemics - and to provide whater shelter before the hard days of winter

But the Navy's here, and the people of these tragic islands know they are with friends.
