The tour moves on - to a proud Maori gathering at Waitangi. On this his toric ground, 113 years ago, their forbears first swore allegiance to Queen Victoria. And now to commemorate that sacred Treaty, a proud people welcome that Queen Elizabeth The Sacred Treaty.

On arrival, the Queen and the Duke (accompanied by Mr Holland), the Projection are confronting by a fearsome warrior, asking whether they come in peace?

And placing curved sticks, representing ancient Tribal Gods in front of them.

And then the ceremonial dances of welcome processing that the Queen was

During the welcome at Waitangi, the Queen heard a Maori plea, asking her to visit King Koroki, the head of the Waikoto tribes, at his village. Leeping with Maori custom. And this she did - during the drive to Hemilton.

before leaving, the Queen entered the King's marae, or private courtyard - an act that won the loyal effection of a tribe that never took part in the original Maori Oath of Allegiance.
