As aprelude to the air tragedy, we show you this Hertfordshire landscape under its first mantle of snow - a fall that routed visions of an early Spring, and the cause, perhaps, of a terrible disaster.

Yes, Winter had come, when a Valetta Transport plane crashed into the thickly-wooded slepes of a Hartfordshire hillside, near Albury,... just after taking off from Bovingdon aerodrome.

The plane was carrying sixteen R.A.F. personnel, returning home in the snows form after playing a second round Rugby Cup Mxxxx Tie at Halton Camp. The tangled mass of wreckage was strewn in all directions. Parts of the plane can be seen embedded in tree trunks - striking testimony to the force of the impact.
