Berlin - ~~was~~ In the Eastern Sector of the City, Russian troops are joined by women and children for the Red Army Day Parade.

~~and~~ In solemn procession, they make their annual pilgrimage, through the Brandenburg Gate, to the Russian War Memorial in the British Zone - to honour those ~~of the~~ who died in the Second World War.

M.I.G. Tested

Cross Country
