Glasgow's "Black-out"-

March 2nd. '54.

For ~~three~~ the second time in twenty-four hours, fire engines rased through blacked-out streets to Dalmarnock Power Station, near Glasgow, following a further switchgear explosion.

Daylight revealed blown-out windows, and smoke-grimed walls- grim reminders of this sudden double disaster, WHICH INJURED SEVEN MEN. <sup>3</sup>  
To prevent unauthorised persons entering the Power Station, <sup>POLICE</sup> policemen were posted, ~~at the main gate~~ while <sup>NEARBY</sup> shop windows were boarded up against smash and grab thieves. <sup>93</sup>

~~Though Glasgow suffered the worst power upheaval in its history-~~  
Public services were <sup>LATER</sup> gradually restored. But, for the time being, the Dalmarnock Power Station's chimneys no longer smoke.
