An announcement that follows one of the most detailed aircraft examinations ever made. The Comets were taken out of service following the tragic crash near Elba, last January.

Since then, technicians have worked unceasingly. Some planes have been completely dismantled - others underwent exhaustive routine checks.

In addition, fifty modifications have been made to each aircraft.
