28th May 1954

Off the East Coast of America: The U.S. Aircraft-carrier "Bennington" limps towards Quonset, Rhode Island - the victim of two raveging axplasing explosions and a fire - while on a training cruise.

The explosions occurred between decks, in the fore part of the ship, just after dawn. And as the news was radioed to shore, that casualties were heavy, every available ambulance aiximumiat was mustered at Quonset Point - to await the stricken carrier's return.

on board the "Bennington," the fire raged for four hours - mefare the heroic work of fire-fighting teams brought it under control - before the vessel docked.

brought The casualties were quickly **EXERCISE** ashore - most of them being badlyburned by the inferno that raged between decks.
