

Canada - Duchess opens hydro-scheme-

Canada-- Despite pouring rain, a large crowd cheered the Duchess of Kent when she opened the Kingpin of Ontario's Hydro system-- the Sir Adam Beck Generating Station on the face of the Niagara Gorge.

This ceremony was the climax of three and a half years' record-breaking construction work, to place in service-many months ahead of schedule-- the greatest power development in the history of the Ontario Hydro <sup>System</sup> ~~and~~

The Duchess (with her daughter Princess Alexandra) toured the new station now to Scotland where Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother arrived at Glasgow's Kelvin Hall to open the Scottish Industries Exhibition. This great post-war selling venture was last held in 1949. ~~FOUND.~~

The Queen Mother was, then, presented with a silver tea pot (made in 1750) for her Scottish Home. / So to a tour of the Exhibition, representing 100 industries in Scotland, which many overseas visitors have come to see / S.

The Queen Mother showed great interest in every stand, and there was a special word for a typist who demonstrated a typewriter of the Victorian era.
