

Ireland: Almost engulfed by heavy seas, the main fuselage of the ill-fated Dutch airliner (which crashed into the Shannon) is kept afloat by large air-bags - to aid the work of recovery...

A salvage team from Holland (together with British and Irish experts) has fought a ceaseless battle with the tides - trying to recover the sixty-ton wreckage which may hold the secret of a crash that cost twenty-eight lives. The cockpit section of the airliner is brought ashore. The plane broke into three parts when lashed by storm-driven seas...

Meanwhile, as salvage efforts continue, official investigators are making preliminary examinations of the plane, in their efforts to determine the cause of the tragic disaster.
