Fire at Mount Pleasant-

London--- Over 2000 postal workers- mostly women- were ~~quickly evacuated~~ ^{safely} evacuated when flames roared through the upper ~~sixth~~ floors of the G.P.O premises at Mount Pleasant, Clerkenwell, which deals with three million letters a day.

More than 150 firemen fought for three hours to control a blaze which threatened tons of mail at the world's largest sorting office.

The fire, which burnt out the top storey, is believed to have started in a lift in the supply department.
