Ireland: Following weeks of gale-force winds and heavy rain that reduced the grain harvest - a further catastrophe overtakes the rich farm-land areas - disastrous floods.

These heart-breaking pictures were taken near Athlone, where more than twenty square miles of farm-land are inundated by the flood waters of the River Shannon. In some places, the river has doubled its normal width and following heavy and prolonged rain

For the farmers - the floods have come as the final crippling blow of a disastrous summer. Many have given up all hope of salvaging their crops - the unfortunate victims of the worst floods in the area for thirty years.

A year of wide-spread flood havor - and the latest country to suffer is italy. Torrential rainstorms, during the night, in the Province of Salerno (the scene of the Allied invasion in 1943) have brought disaster and death from floods and landslides.

Avalanches of mud swept down the mountain-sides to engulf over forty towns and villages. Troops were rushed to stricken areas to dig out the victims from shattered houses and a sea of mud...
