America -- Leaving the Inn where she stayed during her visit to Williamsburg, Virginia - the former State Capital - Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother was assisted into an 18th century phaeton by coloured coachmen, in traditional dress - for a tour of the city. And the cheering crowds in the streets - in almost a typically English setting - must have reminded the Royal visitor of her own Capital, on a bright autumn day (BRING UP)

Arriving in Canada, the Queen Mother received an affectionate welcome back to Ottawa, after an interval of fifteen years, from the Governor-General, Mr. Vincent Massey. Her Majesty inspected a Guard of Honour of the Black Watch of Canada, of which she is Honorary Colonel-in-Chief. (BRING UP)

Later, the Queen Mother added her tribute to the wealth of tokens at the memorial column in Confederation Square, and brought a word of comfort and cheer to veterans of two world wars - many of them sadly disabled, before passing on to fulfil other engagements during her five-day visit to Canada (BRING UP)
