Paris - Deputies vote

Paris: For eleven days, bitter debate raged in the French National Assembly - while outside, demonstrators carried gruesome reminders of the past - pictures of Nazi concentration camps and gas chambers. Against this background of tragic memory: of three German occupations in eighty years - the Chamber of Deputies finally ^{approved} ~~ratified~~ the Paris Agreement to re-arm Germany - by a narrow margin. ^{an} historic decision and a triumph for Premier Mendes-France.

South Africa: The peace of a summer's day in Johannesburg was rudely shattered, when sheets of rain, and hail ^{of} the size of pigeon's eggs - suddenly covered the streets a foot thick with drifts like snow.
