German rail crash

Germany: Grim aftermath of a ~~terrible rail disaster~~<sup>crash</sup> on the bridge spanning the Aller River, ~~at Warden~~<sup>NEAR BREMEN</sup>, when a goods train (with seven petrol waggons) jumped the rails. A passenger train coming from the opposite direction, ~~crashed~~<sup>HURTLED</sup> into the wreckage.

The petrol trucks exploded, starting a fire which burned ~~through~~<sup>throughout</sup> the night. The driver and fireman of the passenger train were killed.
