

London: This is the new control centre for civil aviation - located on the fringe of London Airport. The long-range radar scanner enables skilled operators to plot, on the screen, all air traffic operating over Southern England. /s

On the airfield itself, the traffic control tower is situated in the heart of the new Central Terminal - and affords a commanding view of all runways - on the busiest civil airport in Europe. /
