Portland: Submarine "Sidon" raised

In Portland Harbour, darkness shrouds the scene of grim tragedy as salwage workers wage a non-stop battle to raise the ill-fated submarine, "Sidon" - which sank, following an explosion.

For twenty-one hours, the fight continued. Often the lifting hawsers were fouled by floating debris - almost as if the sea was loath to surrender its victim. Then came the successful lift, and the submarine, supported by huge buoyancy cylinders (known as "camels), broke surface. Later, that morning, the submarine was plainly visible, with the heavy list to starboard that hampered the subsequent beaching operation. Meanwhile, a distress fund has been opened for the dependents of the TH'S thirteen victims of a tragic Naval disester.
