First pictures: Bombs in Buenos Aires

Argentina: These dramatic on-the-spot pictures of the bombing raids on Example Buenos Aires were taken during the recent revolt by units of the Naval Forces against the Peron regime.

The attacks were centred egainst the Plaza de Mayo, (the Whitehall of Buenos Aires) causing damage - while heavy fighting broke out between the rebel forces and the loyal Army troops.

Two separate bombing raids were made on Government House - leaving a trail of death and destruction in the City. Reports estimated the killed and injured at well over a thousand.

Then - to add to the general confusion - mobs (described as led by manunists) set to pillage and set fire to Roman Catholic Churches...

The Cardinal's Residence was also attacked - an unhappy sequel to the recent bitterness between Church and State.
