Security Measures in Cyprus-

Cyprus-- In Famagusta, a dusk-to dawn curfew is in operation following a new wave of terrorism, when a police station was ~~practically~~ partially wrecked by a time-bomb. Following the explosion, many suspects are brought in for interrogation.

Meanwhile, ~~xxxxxhighlymobilestrikingforce~~ the British Colonial Police are training a new highly mobile striking force that will eventually number 300. Quick to act in an emergency, it will effectively <sup>deal</sup> ~~cope~~ <sup>with</sup> rioting, without resorting to bloodshed.
