Scotland: First Newsreel pictures of the nuclear power reactor, now being constructed at Dounreay, Caithness. One advanced type (known as the a "breeder reactor" because it produces more fuel than it consumes) will be housed in a <sup>giant</sup> steel sphere - to ensure complete safety.

Built near the coast (because large quantities of water will be needed for cooling purposes) the station, unlike Harwell, will deal mainly with practical research.
