Train crash

London: Tragic aftermath of a night collision, when a Windsor-bound electric train crashed into the rear of a goods-train between Barnes and Putney.

Within minutes, the front coach of the electric train burst into flames. The Minister of Transport, Mr Boyd-Carpenter, was early on the scene of a disaster, which unhappily caused ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ the death of thirteen - with injuries to over forty passengers.

Churchill speaks at Woodford

Woodford: In his first major political ^{SPEECH} since the General Election, (to Young Conservatives in his Constituency), Sir Winston Churchill referred to the Russian Leaders' tour of India and Burma. SOUND
