Coventry- Bombed Cathedral will rise again-

Coventry was in radiant mood when the Queen, accompanied by the Buke of Edinburgh, paid her first visit to the city since her **XERMAN** Coronation, and was received by **THE** Lord Willoughby de Broke, Lord Lieutenant of Warwickshire, and the Lord Mayor-Alderman Dewis An inspection of the Guard of Honour was the prelude to the main **EXAMPLE** object of **Her** visit- the laying of the foundation stone of the new ultra-modern Cathedral.

Side by side with the old city- always a thriving industrial centre of the Midlands- rises a new Coventry- proudly showing its Sovereign the healed scars of war.

Inspecting a model of the reconstruction scheme, the Queen marvelled at the progress made in the rebuilding of the City Centre And the Royal Visitors made a tour of the 15th century Cathedral Her Majesty paused just as her father had done nearly 16 years ago, after that devastating devastating <u>marked</u> in chemy. At the entrance to the crypt chapel, the Archbishop of Canterbury, (wearing the glittering cope he wore for the Queen's Coronation,) to other Church Dignitaries, received the Queen and the Duke. As the Farty stood by the Sanctuary, they saw the burniched Coventry Cross of nails, which was recovered from the charred timbers of the old building.

So the Queen performed this most moving ceremony- a symbol of **xizt** victorhous faith the re-birth of a hoble House of God, that will, one day, stand in the heart of this brave city.
