Italian fashions

Italy: Reviving memories of a past era, the stately rooms of the Royal Palace of Caserta, near Naples, resound again, to the tread of a fashionable company - though with a 20th century look. The occasion was a Fashion Parade, staged by leading Italian Couturiers. And the lovely gardens of the Palace formed an ideal background to Spring and Summer fashions.

Memorial Parade

London: Remembrance in Hyde Park, when the Duke of Gloucester, as Patron of the Combined Cavalry Old Comrades, took the salute at a Service to mark the unveiling of the Cavalry Memorial.

Among the veterans "on parade" was 92 year-old Mr Hind (who fought at the battle of Teleskebir, in 1882) honouring a solemn pledge to remember those who fell in Two World Wars.
