## Italian pashions

Italy: Reviving memories of a past era, the stately rooms of the Royal Palace of Caserta, near Naples, resound again, to the tread of a fashionable company - though with a 20th century look.

The occasion was a Fashion Parade, staged by leading Italian Couturiers.

#### Memorial Parade

Coty, the President of the Republic Amid the most stringent security precautions, the two Heads of State to drove together from the Elysses Palace, where the President and his wife were staying.

Later, the distinguished guest visited the Arc de Triomphe - where he paid tribute at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
