

Germany: To be honoured by a former enemy is a distinction reserved only for the truly great - and this final seal on an illustrious career, brought Sir Winston Churchill to Aachen, to receive the Charlemagne Prize.

Besides the medallion, the veteran statesman received an illuminated address - to mark his services to West European Unity.
