Canada: A sudden outbreak of fire brings disaster to Montreel, with St. Gabriel's Church the centre of a desperate battle to save the 56 year old building.

Firemen from eighteen stations poured and the last 145,000 gallons of water per minute on to the blaze as they fought to gain control. The inside of the Church was gutted, but fortunately, Parish priests and local control saved many of the valuable ornaments and vestments And from America, comes once of the Newsreel pictures of the year as thousands of tons of rock crashes from the face of mighty Niagara Falls Loosened by seeping waters, the falling rock virtually wiped out a major power station that supplied most of New York State. One workman was killed, while the damage has been estimated at and one hundred million dollars: the costlicst rockfall in Niagara's history
