

America: One of the problems of the jet age ~~is~~ to increase the range of fighter-bombers. This has ~~not~~ been solved by mid-air refuelling - an old technique brought up-to-date.

Using the "probe and drogue" method, a flying tanker refuels three Sabre Jets at the same time; and at four hundred miles per hour, ~~that~~ calls for precision flying.

Modern techniques, too, for the Infantry: anti-tank guns are replaced by small guided missiles designed to knock out armoured units. Demonstrated at New Mexico, the new weapon is known as "the Dart" - but this one, never misses the bullseye.

-SO HAVE ANOTHER LOOK: Another old idea sets the pattern for jet-age progress - the famous Gatling gun gets a modern counterpart - the Vulcan, a 20m.m. cannon.
