Germany: As the authorities at Spandau Prison prepared to release former Grand-Admiral Doenitz, the West Berlin Police ~~do~~ ^{do} their utmost to hinder the work of press photographers. Meanwhile - ~~and~~ the 65 year-old Admiral, who had completed ^{his} ten year ^{Nuremberg} sentence as a War Criminal (~~passed upon him at the Nuremberg Trial~~) left by a side entrance.

Admiral Doenitz who ~~was~~ succeeded Hitler as Fuehrer, in 1945, then flew to Dusseldorf - where he gave an interview to the Press and met members of his family.

Cyprus

Cyprus: As a new bout of terrorism sweeps the island, British troops are making constant patrols - tearing down ~~the~~ banners and placards - calling for ~~union~~ ^{UNION} with Greece. Following this recent outburst (when eight Britons were killed in five days) constant round-ups are being made in the search for hidden weapons - as the unhappy wave of violence continues.

Germany

Germany: As a lesson on modern airpower, students from the NATO Defence College, near Paris, visited a demonstration of Western air and ground equipment, at the U.S. Air Force Base, Landstuhl. During the show, a tactical jump by Airborne Infantry (complete with heavy equipment) featured the rapid deployment of a military force. The young officers were also briefed on the Matador Guided Missile - as NATO strength underlines the modern message "Power for Peace!"
