Pipe-line

In Spain, the ^{building} ~~construction~~ of American Air Bases brought one major problem. How to transport vast supplies of fuel over inadequate roads.

^{The} difficulty ~~has~~ has now been overcome by the construction of a multi-channel pipe-line - stretching 485 miles from the Roza Naval Base - to the interior.

Complete with pumping stations and storage tanks, the pipe-line can carry various grades of fuel at the same time. ^{It} ~~It~~ will be completed early next year.
